

SchoolNet Secure Tester

- Provides a secure testing environment for students taking tests online.
- While testing, students will not be able to access other programs (calculators, web browsers, etc.) on the same computer.
- Used for Grade 3 re-take and summer programming post-tests
- Supports the following:
 - Windows
 - MacOS
 - ChromeOS (Chromebook)
- **Does NOT** support iPad
- Students **MUST** log into SchoolNet (tn-student.schoolnet.com) in a browser and set their permanent password **before** logging into the Secure Tester application

SchoolNet Secure Tester Installation

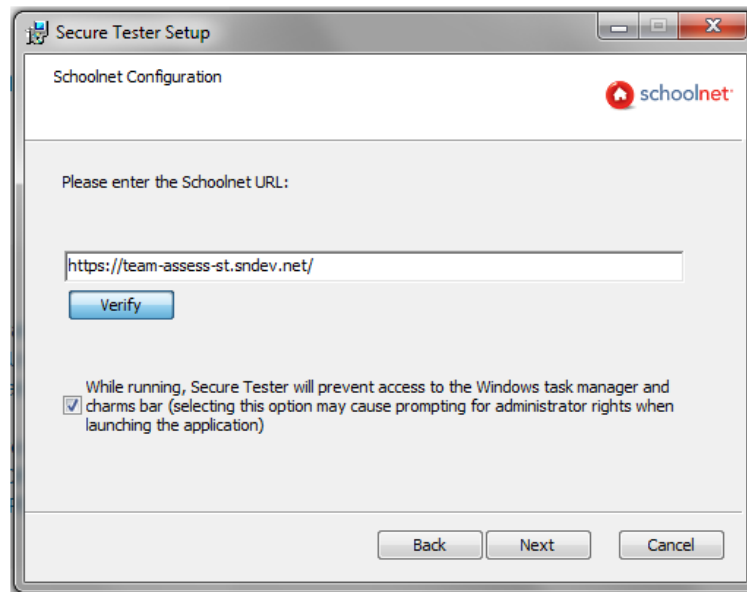
- Secure Tester must be loaded to each testing device.
- Installation guides:

- Important: Secure Tester Install must point to each district's URL:
 - <https://tn.schoolnet.com/tenant id>
 - Tenant ID = District Number (no leading zero)
 - **Example:** <https://tn.schoolnet.com/171> for Alamo
 - <https://tn.schoolnet.com/61> for Cleveland City

Downloading Secure Tester (MACs and Windows)

- Sign in to the Schoolnet support site at <https://support.schoolnet.com>
 - Username: support
 - Password: iloveschoolnet
- Select **Secure Tester** from the drop-down, and then click Search
- Click the **Download** button below the latest Secure Tester version (2.3.7 Win; 1.4.5 Mac)
- Click **Save File**.
- Double-click the download to launch the Secure Tester Setup Wizard, which will guide you through the rest of the installation process.


Setting up Secure Tester (Mac/Win)

- When prompted, enter your district's Schoolnet URL.
 - **Caution:** This URL cannot be changed after installation is complete. Secure Tester must be uninstalled then reinstalled to make changes to this information.
- URL: https://tn.schoolnet.com/tenant_id
- Tenant ID = District Number (no leading zero)
 - Example: <https://tn.schoolnet.com/171> for Alamo;
 - <https://tn.schoolnet.com/61> for Cleveland City



Downloading Secure Tester (Chromebook)

- Sign into the Admin Console for your domain.
- In the Admin Console, go to **Devices > Chrome Management**.
- Click **Device settings**
- Scroll down to **Kiosk Settings**, and then click **apps & extensions page**.

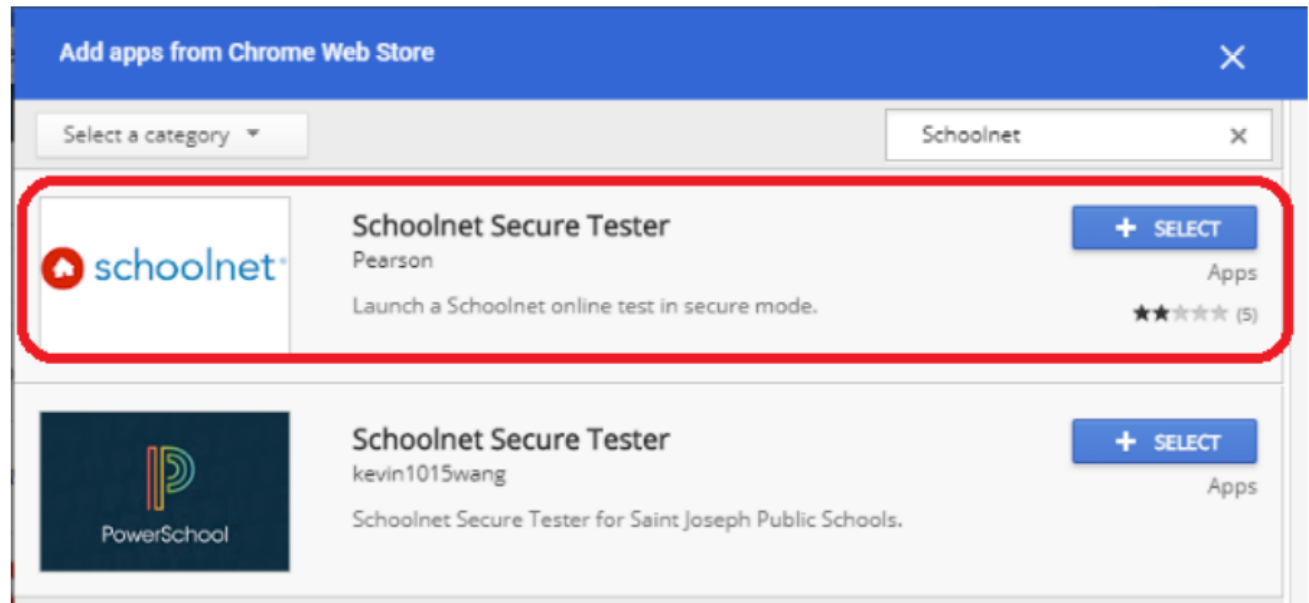

Downloading Secure Tester (Chromebook)

- Find **Schoolnet Secure Tester** in the **Total to Install** column
- Click **Select** for the **Schoolnet Secure Tester** kiosk app that shows **Pearson** as the publisher, and then click **Save**.



Setting up Secure Tester (Chromebook)

- In the Admin console, go to **Device Management > Chrome Management**.
- Click **Apps & extensions**.
- Click **Schoolnet Secure Tester**.
- Under **Kiosk Settings**,
 - scroll down to **Policy for extension** and add the following json with the correct schoolnet URL.
 - <https://tn.schoolnet.com/tenantid>

- **Steps for students to launch Secure Tester:**

1. Launch Secure Tester (icon loaded to device)
2. Agree to the following prompt:

Do you trust https://tn.schoolnet.com?

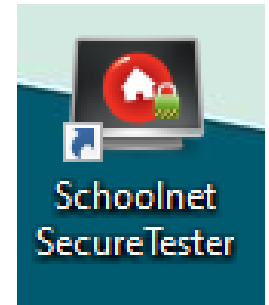
- This site wants to take control of your PC.

- Password;
- Online Passcode for sample test (**WU8WA3LY8**)

– 4. click **Login**
